

St. John Uniform Policy and Shopping Information



WHAT kind of uniforms?

Dress Uniforms - Mass days (Fridays, Feast days, other special occasions designated by the school)

Casual Uniforms – All other days

School Shirts (screenprints) – May be worn on spirit wear days (Mondays) or other days, as noted by teachers/administrators.

Fleece- Navy Fleece featuring the St. John crest are available from Lands' End Uniforms. Fleece may be worn during the school day in the classrooms and during Mass.

Sweaters – Navy, button-up cardigan sweaters with or without the school crest may be worn with uniforms.

No hoodies or other types of sweatshirts may be worn in classrooms or hallways.

Masks if students choose to wear a mask they can have any color, pattern, or design as long as it is appropriate for school.

WHO makes the rules?

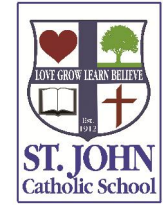
- The **Principal** always has the final say on the uniform policy or questions
- HSA does NOT govern uniform policy and we offer Uniform Exchange as a service to the school and defer to the principal on all guidelines

Uniform Guidelines for All Students



- Walking shorts may be worn on any casual day at the discretion of the parents. Shorts should be longer than student fingertips and no shorter than 4" above the knee.
- No logos, brands, insignias, or trims of any kind are to adorn any clothing, with the exception of athletic shoes and the St. John school crest.
- Jeans (on spirit wear or free dress days) should be appropriate for school and modest in nature. No ripped, torn jeans with holes are permitted. Yoga pants are not allowed. Leggings may be worn under skirts or jumpers only. In the case of free dress, leggings may be worn under dresses or skirts only (not as the bottom to a shirt)
- Non-visible shorts must be worn under jumpers and skirts at all times unless wearing leggings.
- Jewelry is to be limited to two items excluding earrings. Only small earrings (one per ear) may be worn by girls. Rubber bracelets or pony tail holders worn on ankles or wrists are regarded as jewelry and are included in the limit of two.
- Hair accessories for girls must be modest in style and size and need to be the uniform plaid colors or a solid **uniform color**. No extensions of any kind, including but not limited to hair matching swatches, feathers, tinsel, toys, etc.
- No extremes in hair are permitted (unnatural colors, bleaching, style, or length). Mohawk style haircuts are not permitted.
- Length of hair for boys should not be longer than to the top of the eyebrow and neatly trimmed at the top of the collar.
- No facial hair.
- Make-up: Elementary students: no make-up allowed. Middle school girls are allowed simple base or covering only.
- Nail polish (except clear), artificial nails, lip stick, fake eye lashes, tattoos, or body piercings are never permitted.
- Undershirts/underclothing must be solid white.

Shoes



All shoes must fit properly, with closed heel and toe, flat heels and no platforms.

Permitted:

- Athletic shoes
- Dress shoes (solid black, navy, or brown)(not required for Mass)

Not Permitted:

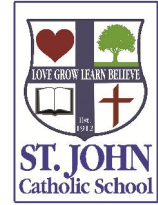
- Boots
- Sandals
- Light up shoes
- Wheeled shoes
- Shoes with extreme patterns, excessive beading or glitter, flashing lights, wheels, characters (cartoon), or inappropriate logos (for example: skull and cross bones)

Since shoe styles available are constantly changing in the stores please check with **the administration** if you have a doubt about the appropriateness of the shoe.

Even if the student has worn the shoes, if they are considered inappropriate or extreme, they will not be allowed to wear them back to school.



What if I don't follow the uniform policy?



If students make choices in their appearance that do not conform to the school dress code policy, the school may exercise the following options:

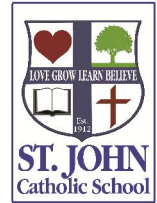
1st offense: A letter &/or email will be sent home to the parent. This must be signed and returned.

2nd offense: The parent will be called to bring appropriate uniform attire. The student will receive a conduct mark. The student may be required to walk laps during recess.

3rd and any continued offense: The child will be removed from school. He/she may return to school when compliant with the uniform code.

It is the responsibility of parents to make sure the dress code is observed. Your cooperation is appreciated.

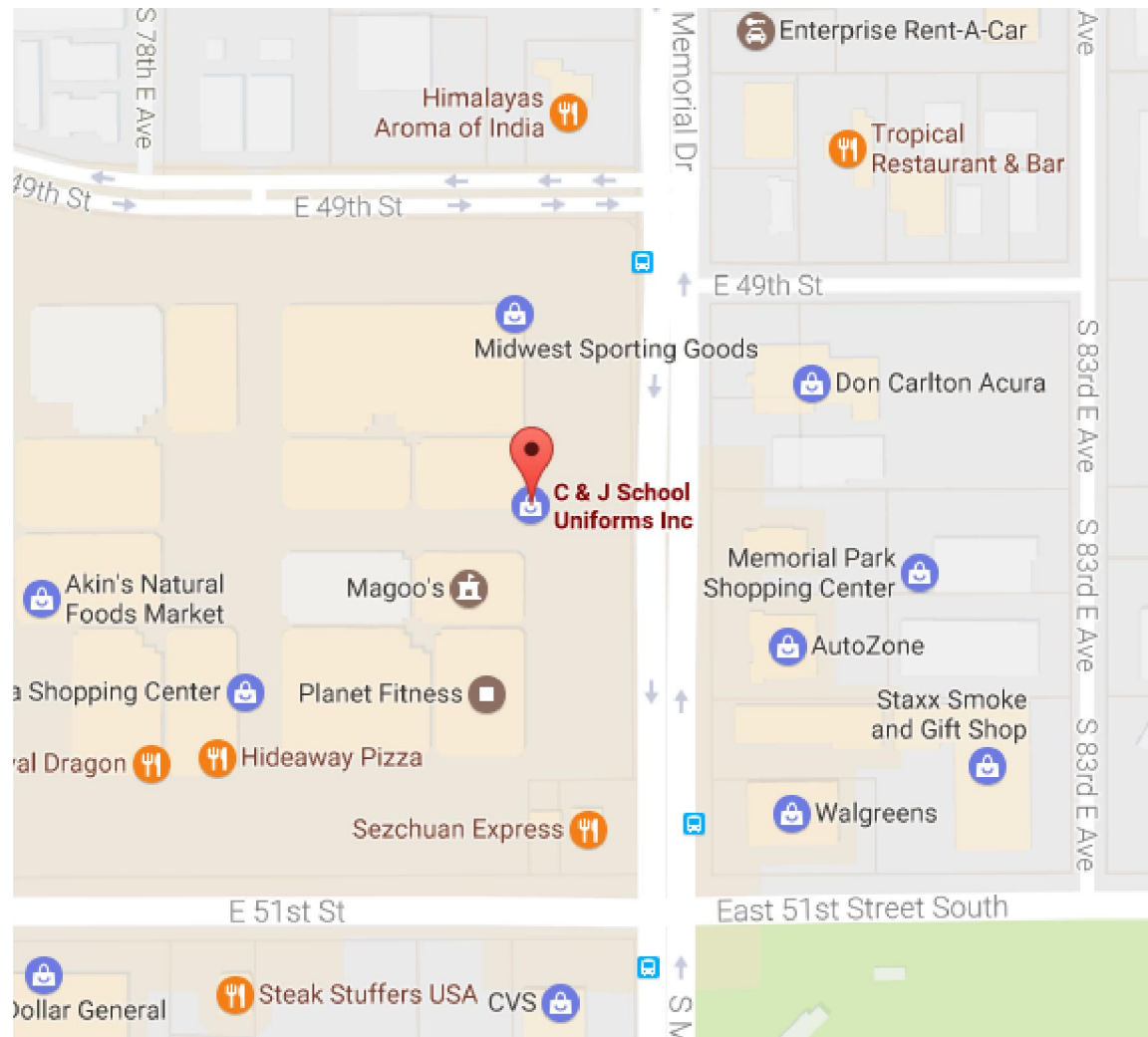

Pre-K 3 and Pre-K 4 Uniform

Clothes	• Same as grades K-5
Shoes	Shoes with rubber soles and socks must be worn every day No clogs, sandals, flip flops, croc-style shoes, slip-ons, or boots No light up shoes, wheeled shoes, or extreme styles or designs (including but not limited to excessive glitter/rhinestones, skull and crossbones, cartoon characters, etc.) Shoes should fasten with either Velcro, well tied laces, or a buckle
Jewelry/Make-up	• Jewelry is limited to two excluding earrings worn by girls. Only small earrings, one per ear may be worn by girls. Rubber bracelets counts as jewelry. No make-up allowed.
Hair	• No extremes in hair are permitted (unnatural color, bleaching, style, or length) • Length of hair for boys should not be longer than to the top of the eyebrow and neatly trimmed at the top of the collar • Mohawk style haircuts are not permitted
Socks	• Solid White, Navy or black socks • No logos are permitted on the socks
Fleece/Sweatshirt	• Navy St. John Zip-up Fleece Jackets and button up cardigan Sweaters (no hoods) may be worn in classrooms. Crests are optional on sweaters and mandatory on fleece jackets.

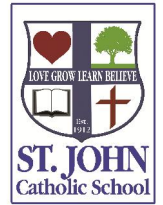
Dress Uniform

Blouse	Tailored, white blouse (either long or short sleeved, peter-pan or straight collar)
Jumper	Classic Navy Plaid Jumper (available at Lands' End only)(non-visible shorts must be worn under jumper) It should be longer than student's fingertips and no more than 4" above the knee.
Socks or Tights	- Socks for all students must be solid white, black or navy - No logos are allowed on socks - Girls may also wear solid white, black, or navy knee socks, tights or leggings (under jumper only)
Shoes	- Dress shoes are permitted, but not required - See Shoe portion of Dress Code for details on types of permitted footwear
Cardigan/Fleece	Navy blue, button-up, crew-neck sweaters may be worn during Mass (with or without the crest)

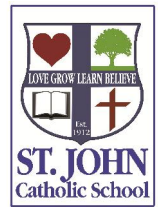
Polo	Light blue non-textured polo-style collared knit shirt (either long or short sleeved)
Pants	Proper fitting, tailored navy pants (no cargo pants, pants with rivets/jean style)
Belts	Plain navy, brown, or black (grades 1-8)(worn with pants or shorts with belt loops only)OPTIONAL
Shorts	Proper fitting, tailored navy walking shorts (no more than 4" above the knee and longer than student fingertips when down at their sides.)
Jumper	Classic Navy Plaid Jumper (available at Lands' End only)(non-visible shorts must be worn under jumper)
Socks/Tights/Leggings	Socks, knee socks, tights or leggings that are solid white, black, or navy may be worn.
Shoes	See Shoe portion of Dress Code for details on types of permitted footwear
Fleece/Sweaters	St. John Navy zip-up Fleece with crest and navy, button-up, crew-neck Sweaters may be worn (sweaters are crest optional)

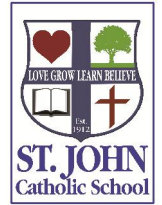
Dress Uniform

Skirt	• Classic Navy plaid pleated skirt; skirt length no shorter than 4" above knee and longer than student's fingertips.
Blouse	• Tailored, white blouse (either long or short sleeved)
Tie	• Navy blue criss-cross tie
Socks and Tights	• Socks for all students must be solid white, black or navy • No logos are permitted on the socks • Girls may also wear solid white, black, or navy knee socks, tights or leggings (under skirts only)
Shoes	• Dress shoes are permitted, but not required • See Shoe portion of Dress Code for details on types of permitted footwear
Cardigan/Fleece	• St. John Navy zip up Fleece with crest or Navy blue, button-up, crew-neck cardigans may be worn.

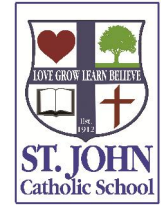
Polo	Solid Light blue, non-textured polo-style collared knit shirt (either long or short sleeved) (6th-7th) Class selected color polo-style collared knit shirt w/ logo (8TH GRADE ONLY)(long or short sleeves)
Pants	• Proper fitting, tailored khaki or navy pants (no cargo pants, pants with rivets/jean style)
Belt	• Plain navy, brown, or black (worn with pants or shorts with belt loops only)
Skirt	• Classic Navy plaid pleated, solid navy or khaki skirt length no shorter than 4" above knee.
Shorts	• Proper fitting, tailored navy or khaki walking shorts; no shorter than 4" above and longer than student's fingertips.
Socks and Tights	Socks for all students must be solid white, black or navy Logos of any sort are not permitted on socks • Girls may also wear solid white, black, or navy knee socks, tights or leggings (under skirt only)
Shoes	• See Shoe portion of Dress Code for details on types of permitted footwear.
Cardigan/Fleece	• St. John Navy zip-up Fleece with crest and navy, button-up, crew-neck sweaters may be worn. (sweaters are crest optional)

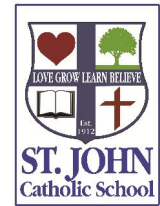
Dress Uniform

Pants	• Proper fitting, tailored navy pants (no cargo pants, pants with rivets/jean style)
Belt	• Plain navy, brown, or black (grades 1-8)(worn with pants or shorts with belt loops only) Optional
Dress Shirt	• Solid white dress shirt (either short or long sleeved)
Tie	• Classic Navy plaid necktie (optional)
Socks	• Socks for all students must be solid white, black or navy • No logos are permitted on the socks
Shoes	• Dress shoes are permitted, but not required • See Shoe portion of Dress Code for details on types of permitted footwear
Cardigan	• St John Navy zip-up fleece with crest and navy blue, button up cardigan sweaters may be worn

Polo	• Solid light blue, non-textured, polo-style collared knit shirt (either long or short sleeved)
Pants	• Proper fitting, tailored navy pants(no cargo pants, pants with rivets/jean style or skinny pants)
Shorts	Proper fitting, tailored navy walking shorts; no shorter than 4" above knee and longer than student fingertips
Socks	• Socks for all students must be solid white, black or navy • No logos are permitted on the socks
Shoes	• See Shoe portion of Dress Code for details on types of permitted footwear.
Fleece/Sweatshirt	• St. John Navy zip-up Fleece with crest and navy , cardigan Sweaters may be worn
Belt	• Plain navy, brown, or black (grades 1-8)(worn with pants or shorts with belt loops only)OPTIONAL

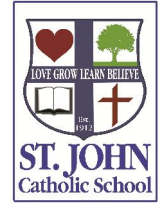

Dress Uniform

Pants	• Proper fitting, tailored khaki or navy pants (no cargo pants, pants with rivets/jean style)
Shorts	• No shorts are to be worn on Mass days
Belt	• Plain navy, brown, or black (worn with pants with belt loops only)
Dress Shirt	• Solid white dress shirt (either short or long sleeved)
Tie	• Classic navy plaid neck tie (REQUIRED)
Socks	• Socks for all students must be solid white, black or navy • No logos are permitted on the socks
Shoes	• Dress shoes are permitted, but not required. • See Shoe portion of Dress Code for details on types of permitted footwear
Cardigan / Fleece	• St. John Navy zip-up Fleece with crest and/or navy blue, V-neck, button up cardigan may be worn.

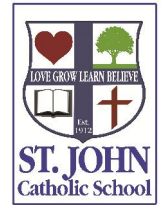
Polo	Solid Light blue, non-textured, polo-style collared knit shirt (either long or short sleeved) (6th-7th) Class selected color polo-style collared knit shirt w/ logo(8TH GRADE ONLY)(long or short sleeves)
Pants	• Proper fitting, tailored khaki or navy pants (no cargo pants, pants with rivets/jean style)
Shorts	• Proper fitting, tailored khaki or navy walking shorts (no shorter than 4" above knee and longer than student's fingertips)
Belt	• Plain navy, brown, or black (worn with pants or shorts with belt loops only)
Socks	• Socks for all students must be solid white, black or navy • No logos are permitted on the socks
Shoes	• See Shoe portion of Dress Code for details on types of permitted footwear.
Cardigan/Fleece	• St. John Navy zip-up Fleece with crest and navy, cardigan may be worn; however the fleece is NOT permitted to be worn during Mass.
