SCHOOL & COMMUNITY

Since 1960, Bishop Kelley High School has served as the only Catholic Diocesan high school in Tulsa.

Bishop Kelley operates on a two-term, 4x4 block schedule. Each student is required to take comprehensive exams for each core course.

The professional staff at Bishop Kelley includes 81 teachers, counselors, administrators and specialists. We have three diocesan priests and one Christian Brother. Half of the faculty have advanced degrees; 46% have more than 10 years teaching experience at Bishop Kelley High School.

RETREATS

Students have the opportunity to go on a retreat with their own grade every year. Seniors have the opportunity to be leaders at retreats for underclassmen.

SERVICE OPPORTUNITIES

Bishop Kelley hosts many service opportunities a year. There are also service projects that partner with local businesses to help those in our local community. Mission trips occur three times per school year, including a trip over spring break.

You can estimate a 3-6% tuition increase annually to cover standard increases in operating expenses.

TUITION ASSISTANCE

Financial assistance is based on the parents' financial ability to pay as determined by FACTS tuition management program and reviewed by a financial aid committee. *All tuition assistance information is confidential.*

Regrettably, we are not able to meet the financial aid needs of all students who apply. All decisions are made on a year-by-year basis. There can be no assurance that a student receiving financial assistance in one year will be offered financial assistance at a comparable level in any subsequent year.

FACTS applications open January 1, 2020. The FACTS tuition assistance application deadline is April 15, 2020. This application will be used for all sources of tuition assistance awarded, including the diocesan St. Francis of Assisi Tuition Assistance Trust and GO for Catholic Schools.
